Requested Information for Short Researcher Mobility Proposal

The Institut Français in Finland, the Embassy of France in Finland and the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation have partnered with the Finnish Society of Sciences and Letters to initiate and strengthen bilateral cooperation in science, innovation and higher education in fields of excellence in both countries.

In order to initiate or strengthen cooperation in science, innovation and higher education, this program will allow selected researchers from France and from Finland (both ways) to visit their counterparts for a short period (1-2 weeks). The objectives of such visit are:

- To discuss potential concrete collaboration on research and, if possible, on higher education (mobility of students, dual degrees, joint PhD cotutelle)
- To meet with several researchers within the host institution to explore all possible other collaborations, also in a multidisciplinary approach
- To identify short, medium and long term perspectives of collaborations and official cooperation formalization in order to build a sustainable cooperation between research teams, research laboratory, departments and institutions.
- Communicate on the visit and the research results of the collaboration

The Institut Français in Finland, the Embassy of France in Finland, the French Ministry of Education, Higher Education and Research and the Finnish Society of Sciences and Letters will cover airfare and accommodation for each researcher through a grant of up to **1000 euros**.

The selection committee is comprised of representatives of partnered institutions.

Proposal

- **Researcher's name and affiliations**
- **Short CV (max 2 pages) of the researcher with major publications and awards**
- **Proposed dates of stay**
- **Proposed agenda (if possible please schedule at least one talk at the Department level with colleagues and students + allow time within the stay for media communication)**
- **University Host and Department**
- **Objectives of the visit**
- **Short abstract of the common scientific collaborations and the expected outcomes of the visit (400 words maximum)**
- **A short biography of the researcher (200 words maximum)**
- **A picture 300 dpi or greater of the researcher**
- **A short biography of the host researcher (200 words maximum)**
- **A picture 300 dpi or greater of the host researcher**

Please be aware that you will have to acknowledge the support provided by the Institut Français de Finlande, the Embassy of France in Finland the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation and the Finnish Society of Sciences and Letters by using our logos in any communication material (leaflet, website, emails for talk invitation ...).

Note that a 2 pages report (including final agenda/conclusions on science collaborations and outcomes/ final budget) will be asked within 2 weeks after the end of the visit.
