



## MOBILITY PROGRAM FINN'EST Frequently Asked Questions

### Frequently Asked Questions: short exchange program of 3 weeks (Finnish) / 4 weeks (French)

#### 1. How much does it cost?

Since it is a reciprocal exchange between families, the students are accommodated and fed by the host family, on each side.

The costs related to the organisation of the trip (flying tickets, etc.) are borne by the family.

The families are advised to give a little bit of pocket money to their child to allow him/ her to benefit from the leisure activities in the hosting country. For information, a ticket to the movies in France costs between 8 and 10 euros and a coffee 1,70 euros.

#### 2. What do the student and the family commit to?

The student commits to:

- Attend all the classes in the French hosting school with his pair.
- Adapt to the style of life of the hosting family.
- Take care of the student with whom he has been paired for all the duration of his/ her stay in Finland.

The hosting family commits to:

- Welcome the student at their home and provide him/ her with the essential needs (accommodation, food, health care if needed)
- Be responsible of the student they host.

#### 3. With whom should the journey be planned?

The travel and the specifics of the journey (dates, transportation from the airport, etc.) must be discussed directly between the two families. The French family and the Finnish family must reach an agreement on that topic.
